ABOUT THE LEVEL 5 LEARNING AND SKILLS APPRENTICESHIP

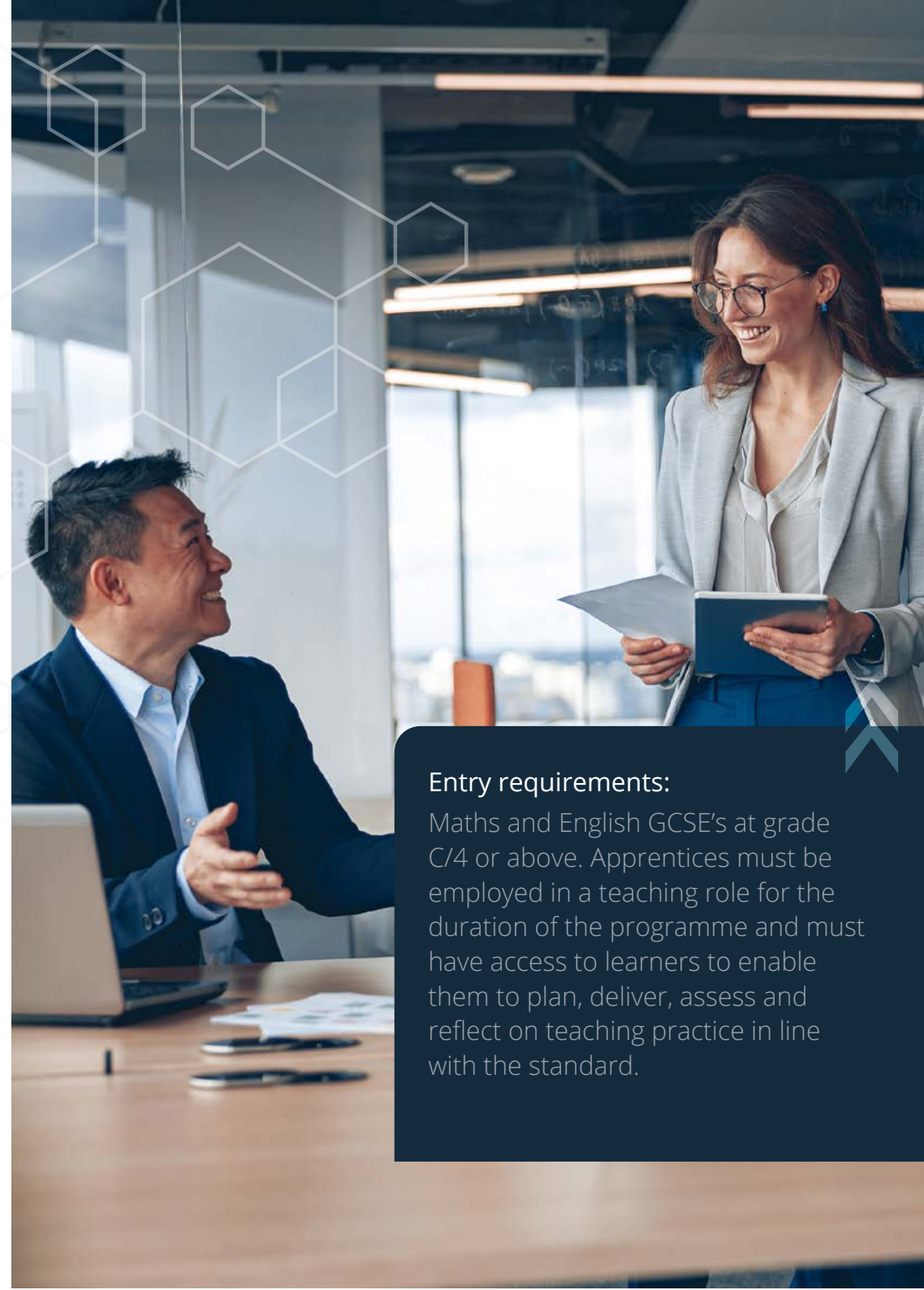
Learning and Skills Teachers support learners of all ages across further education, adult education, independent training providers, higher education and employer led provision.

The apprenticeship is designed for those who teach, train, or assess as part of their role and who are responsible for planning, delivering and evaluating learning.

Apprentices must be employed in a teaching role for the duration of the programme and must have access to learners to enable them to plan, deliver, assess and reflect on teaching practice in line with the standard.

A Learning and Skills Teacher apprentice will develop the ability to:

- Plan inclusive engaging learning sessions
- Deliver teaching that supports progress and achievement
- Use a range of assessment methods to inform learning
- Reflect on and improve professional practice
- Promote equality, diversity, safeguarding and learner wellbeing
- Work collaboratively with colleagues and stakeholders



Entry requirements:

Maths and English GCSE's at grade C/4 or above. Apprentices must be employed in a teaching role for the duration of the programme and must have access to learners to enable them to plan, deliver, assess and reflect on teaching practice in line with the standard.



DELIVERY OF THE APPRENTICESHIP

Delivery is via supported distance learning using live online sessions, interactive workshops, peer discussion and workplace based development. Sessions are highly engaging and apprentice led, allowing participants to learn from peers working in different organisations and sectors.

Apprentices are supported to apply theory directly to their teaching practice ensuring learning is meaningful, relevant and sustained.



What apprentices will learn

During the 18 months 'on programme' element of the course, apprentices will cover modules such as:

- Legislation, Regulations & Codes of Practice
- Widening Teaching Observations
- TLA Strategies
- Safeguarding & British Values
- Learning Needs
- Managing Challenging Behaviour
- Scheme of Work & Lesson Planning
- Theories of Learning
- Curriculum Design
- Political & Economic Influences



OFF-THE-JOB TRAINING

Apprentices complete off the job training which is planned recorded and reviewed throughout the programme. This may include:

- Taught sessions and workshops
- Professional reading and research
- Lesson planning assessment and evaluation activities
- Reflective practice and development time during working hours



Support for the Employer

Support for the Apprentice

Each apprentice is supported by a dedicated Vocational Skills Coach, alongside our Safeguarding and Wellbeing Teams.

Progress is monitored through regular reviews involving the apprentice, employer and coach. These reviews focus on development, progress against the standard and planning meaningful off the job training activities that link directly to teaching practice.

We quality assure all work through our internal quality assurance process to ensure it meets the requirements of the standard. This supports higher level thinking and strong performance at end point assessment.

DURATION OF THE APPRENTICESHIP

Typically it will take 18 months to complete the 'on programme' element of the course, with an additional 3 months to complete end-point assessment.

Formal cohort inputs will be weekly for the first 8 weeks. All remaining sessions will run every 3 weeks. All lessons are live via MS Teams.

PROGRESSION OPPORTUNITIES

On completion apprentices are well placed to progress into senior teaching roles, quality roles, curriculum leadership or specialist education positions. The apprenticeship also supports professional recognition within the sector.

FUNDING

Employers who pay the apprenticeship levy can use their levy funds to support this apprenticeship through their DAS account. The Level 5 Learning and Skills Teacher apprenticeship has a maximum funding band of £7,000.
